It is 1:30/Es la una y media

It is 3:05/Son las tres y cinco

It is 1:02/Es la una y dos

It is 4:10/Son las cuatro y diez

It is 4:10 in the morning/Son las cuatro y diez de la mañana

It is 4:10 in the afternoon/Son las cuatro y diez de la tarde

It is 8:10 in the evening/Son las ocho y diez de la noche

It is ten to one (12:50)/12:50 es la una menos diez

It is five to five (4:55)/Son las cinco menos cinco

It is a quarter to eight (7:45)/Son las ocho menos cuarto

Good morning or good day/Buenos dias

Good afternoon/Buenos tardes

Good evening or good night/Buenos noches

It is midnight/Es la medianoche

It is noon/Es el mediodia
